

CARE AND MAINTENANCE OF NATURAL WOOD VENEER

Natural wood is used for the natural wood veneer.
To maintain the product in its best condition for as long as possible,
follow the maintenance instructions mentioned below.

Basic Maintenance

To remove dust from the surface, use a clean, dry cloth.
To remove residue, clean with a damp cloth working in the direction of the grain.
End with a dry cloth to prevent staining.

How To Get Rid Of Stubborn Stains And Residue

Remove with a damp cloth using a neutral cleaning detergent.
Use clean water afterwards to remove the cleaning agent and end with a dry cloth.

CAUTION

- As much as possible, prevent the surface from becoming wet and always finish with a dry cloth.
(Finishing with a dry cloth helps preserve the product in its best condition.)
- Water or cleaning agent left on the surface or long time exposure to humidity will cause fading of the coated surface and possibly stains, peeling and molding.
- This product is coated in order to prevent staining/markings, however scratching with hard objects will cause irremovable damage.
In case of marking, it is recommended to paint over with the same paint.
- Do not clean with a solvent.
This will damage or cause fading of the coating.
The surface is treated with urethane clear coating and does not require regular maintenance.
Avoid water and humidity, and in case of dust and dirt follow the maintenance instructions mentioned above.
